**What to bring:** If you are spending the night at camp please bring your own bedding, pillow, clothing, toiletries, linens, personal items. Now for the quilting: Bring your sewing machine, extension cord/power strip, fabric scissors, notions, Unfinished Objects (UFOs), Works in Progress (WIPs), whatever you need for quilting! We will have ironing and cutting stations set up for everyone's convenience. This year's charity project is making and providing children's blankets for Project Linus. More information on that when we email you before the retreat. Also we are having a Nine Patch Exchange. Plan to bring about 30 Nine Patch Blocks to exchange one with each participant (exact numbers will be included in your email) and with these you'll be able to make your own unique commemorative quilt! Even more information will be given about this via email.
